1445-10 Minutes of Meeting

The Minutes of the meeting held on 27 September 2010 were approved.

Resolved

1446-10 Yoga

A complaint had been received regarding the heating of the Memorial Hall on Monday and Tuesday evenings from the Yoga instructor. She had been hiring the hall since 2000 and complained that, particularly on Mondays, she regularly experienced an absence of heating. Members noted that the boiler's timer clock had been replaced within the year and that it was set to 'turn on' half an hour prior to each booking. It seemed likely that the clock did not operate as the thermostat failed to 'kick in'. It was recommended that a month long pilot trial with the thermostat being set at a higher temperature threshold Monday and Tuesday evenings (subsequently during September – November) when outside temperatures fluctuated be undertaken. As a sign of goodwill and for the month trial period the yoga instructor would not be invoiced
